

Scarborough and The North York Moors

Sunday 6th to Thursday 10th April 2025

Our first short break of 2025 takes us to the east coast resort of Scarborough, and the sweeping landscapes of the North York Moors National Park. From our base in the bustling seaside town of Scarborough, we'll explore the rugged beauty of the landscape; step back in time at the North Yorkshire Moors Steam Railway; spend time exploring Castle Howard; and enjoy the vibrant town of Whitby, the home of Bram Stoker's 'Dracula'!

Sunday 6th April: We travel from our local departure points to Scarborough via the beautiful Lincolnshire countryside. We will break our journey for an hour before crossing the Humber Bridge and making our way up to our hotel.

Monday 7th April: After breakfast we will travel to the village of Thornton-le-Dale, with thatched cottages, idyllic gardens and small independent shops to enjoy. From there we will travel to Castle Howard where our tickets will include admission to the House and Gardens.



Tuesday 8th April: On Tuesday morning we will make our way to Pickering to catch the steam train. We will ride the full length of the steam line to Grosmont, where we will have free time to explore the station including engine sheds, before our coach takes us to Whitby to enjoy the rest of our day at leisure.



Wednesday 9th April: Wednesday will be a day at leisure. Why not explore Scarborough Castle; go shopping in the town; or visit the seafront attractions. For those more adventurous, the city of York is only an hours train ride away!



Thursday 10th April: After breakfast, we will depart for home, dropping off at our local drop off points.
